MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Happy November! We are now in the final weeks of the church's liturgical year, when the theme of the church's liturgy is focused on the Last Things: death, judgment, heaven and hell. This somber theme is echoed by nature, which has taken on a somber appearance.

I am happy to report that our "October Count" indicates that our average attendance at Sunday Mass has improved considerably since 2021. Our average was below 900 in 2021, and this year, our average is 1,019. I am hoping for continuing improvement.

It is true that the attitude of Catholics toward Mass attendance and the importance of the Sunday obligation has changed over the decades. I have observed this during the years of my priesthood. I have also observed other changes in the attitudes and desires of Catholics regarding the other sacraments and services. In the coming weeks and months, I would like to address some of these developments in the hope of correcting some common misunderstandings and create better appreciation for the church's regulations regarding these sacramental celebrations. Today, I will begin with Baptism, particularly infant Baptism.

The law of the church indicates that infant children of Catholic parent(s) are to be baptized "quam primum," which means "right away," specifically "within the first weeks after birth." Baptism is the sacrament of salvation, by which the one baptized dies and rises to new life with Christ, original sin is washed away, and the person becomes a member of the Body of Christ, the Church. The church considers this important to do as soon as possible, for the sake of the child's salvation. But quite frequently, parents postpone the Baptism of their children for months, perhaps years, because they want to have the Baptism at a time when all the family and relatives can be present for the occasion. This is hard to do as many families are spread out. Of course, it is wonderful to have everyone present for the celebration of Baptism, and if that can be accomplished within a reasonable time, that would be perfect. But the baptism of a newborn child should not be delayed too long simply for this reason because, as Jesus told Nicodemus, "no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit." (Jn 3:5)

That's all for this week. May God grant eternal rest to all the faithful departed, and His blessing to all of you and your loved ones.
