MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, sometimes referred to as the Feast of Corpus Christi. Corpus Christi is Latin, which literally means "Body of Christ."

This feast dates back to at least the 13th century. The feast is meant to celebrate the gift of the Most Holy Eucharist to the church, to remind us of the institution of the Eucharist by Jesus, which took place at the Last Supper, and to emphasize the real and abiding Presence of Christ in the consecrated Bread and Wine, the Sacrament of His Body and Blood, through which He fulfills His promise, "I am with you always, even to the end of the age." (Matthew 28:20)

St. Thomas Aquinas wrote some of the hymns that are associated with this feast and we still sing to honor Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament: Pange Lingua (including the Tantum Ergo), Landa Sion (the sequence for the feast) and Adoro Te Devote (the hymn for the office of the feast).

One of the traditions of this feast is the Procession with the Blessed Sacrament. We revived this tradition last year here at St. Andrew and today, we will once again have a Eucharistic Procession to conclude the 11:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. The procession will lead us outside (weather permitting) and around the church to the front steps of the school where we will sing the Tantum Ergo and end with the Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. It will be a brief, but beautiful sign of devotion and faith in the True Body of Christ (Corpus Christi).

I also take this occasion on the feast of Corpus Christi to remind you of the opportunity to worship and adore our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament every Tuesday from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. in the church. There is Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Adoration during those times and at 8:45 p.m., we conclude with night prayer and Benediction. Currently, we have 10-25 people who attend these hour of Adoration. I would love to see 50 people there every week.

Finally, June is the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. May you have a blessed June, and may you be protected by the Heart of Jesus.






