
Communion Antiphon

Jerusalem, <u>arise</u> and stand up<u>on</u> the heights, and behold the joy which comes to <u>you</u> from God.




O Lord of Light, fill the night. Many have lost their way. O Rising Dawn, shine upon, darkness shall be no more.
