#### MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

It is now the season of "Ordinary Time" in the Church's year. Last Monday at Mass, I spoke in my homily about the meaning of Ordinary Time. Several people told me they appreciated my explanation, so I decided to share it with you.


Ordinary Time is the part of the Church year that is outside of the Advent/Christmas cycle and the Lent/Easter cycle. We may be tempted to think that "ordinary" means something negative, like "plain," "boring," "humdrum," or "commonplace." If it's ordinary, it is "not special." Christmas and Easter are "special," whereas there is nothing special about "ordinary" time.

What makes Ordinary Time different, however, is this: In the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter, we are focused on the saving events in the life of Christ our Lord and Savior; His incarnation and birth; His suffering, death, Resurrection, and Ascension. We recall these events and celebrate them with solemnity and prepare for these solemn feasts by means of penance. Ordinary Time, however, is the time when we listen attentively to Christ's teaching. We listen to His words, His commands, His parables, and His preaching of the Kingdom of God. So, Ordinary Time is when Christ teaches us how to be His disciples! Isn't that extra "ordinary?"

The work on our new lighting in the church is progressing. I hope that by next weekend, everything will be back to normal and our beautiful church will be brightly illuminated and once again, light will shine on those who dwelled in darkness!





#### RESPECT LIFE: DIOCESE OF COLUMBUS

Beginning January 22, 1973, with Roe v. Wade, and during the nearly 50-year period following the Supreme Court decision, nearly 64 million children have been killed, and untold numbers of women and men suffer in the aftermath. Even with the overturning of Roe v. Wade in June 2022, many states do not recognize children in their mothers' wombs as persons warranting protection, and federal laws fail to protect the lives of unborn children. On Thursday, Jan 23, Pro-life advocates across the country, including Bishop Fernandes, will travel to Washington, D.C. as part of the Annual March for Life. 

#### **DAY OF PRAYER AND PENANCE ~**

Wednesday, Jan. 22, is designated as a day of prayer and penance for Catholics in the United States, called the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children."

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), no. 373, directs: In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.



# ST. ANDREW CONFERENCE OF THE SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL 2024 REPORT TO THE PARISH

Vincentian Spirituality is the seeking to bear witness to the love of Christ through prayer, meditation on the scriptures, the teaching of the Church, through our daily lives, and in our relationship with those in need.

During the 2024 Fiscal Year (October 1, 2023 - September 30, 2024), 13 full members and 14 associate members of St. Andrew's Society of St. Vincent de Paul participated in activities to serve those in need. Members responded to 76 requests, assisting 199 individuals and family members. Forty-one in-person consultations were made with neighbors living in our parish area requesting assistance, as well as with other persons referred to our conference by the Columbus SVdP Council. Parishioners' monetary and in-kind donations enabled the St. Vincent de Paul Society to continue works of mercy and helped alleviate suffering for the needy in our local community and in the neediest areas of the Diocese.

#### **WORKS OF MERCY**

Total Dollars Spent: \$43,924 Total Volunteer Hours: 1,527

#### FEED THE HUNGRY/GIVE DRINK TO THE THIRSTY ~ totaling \$5,914 and 710 volunteer hours

- Assist with providing free lunches to the needy at St. Lawrence Haven: 382 volunteer hours.
- Prepare sandwiches for St. Lawrence Haven's free lunch program: \$3,264 plus 249 volunteer hours.
- Contribute bottled water and snacks to St. Lawrence Haven's free lunch program: \$730.
- Contribute to support St. Lawrence Haven's Christmas meals for the needy: \$300.
- Contribute to the distribution of Thanksgiving Baskets at St. James the Less Parish: \$500.
- Deliver food donated by parishioners to St. James the Less Food Pantry: 38 volunteer hours.
- Prepare cooked turkeys for the Thanksgiving meal at St. Lawrence Haven: 31 volunteer hours.
- Provide food gift cards to those in need: \$620.
- Help support the food bank of St. Vincent de Paul conference in Mexico: \$500 plus 10 volunteer hours.

- Conduct parish collection drives of donated clothing, winter hats, gloves, blankets, and linens: 27 volunteer hours (two truckloads of clothing and other items were donated by St. Andrew parishioners).

#### SHELTER THE HOMELESS ~ totaling \$37,465 and 304 volunteer hours

• Assist with payment of rent, utility bills, and other housing expenses of 76 households with a total of 199 family members.

#### VISIT AND COMFORT THE SICK AND ELDERLY ~ totaling \$45 and 153 volunteer hours

- Send cards during Christmas and Easter to homebound parishioners and those in nursing homes: \$45 and 8 volunteer hours.
- Visit the elderly in nursing homes: 145 volunteer hours.

#### BURY THE DEAD ~ totaling \$500 and 150 volunteer hours


- Contribute to help support the SVdP Diocesan Council Funeral Fund: \$500.
