MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend (November 16-17), we celebrate the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time. That means the church year will soon be coming to a close. Next week (November 23-24), we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King on the last Sunday of the liturgical year. On November 30 and December 1, we begin a new year as we observe the First Sunday of Advent. Between now and then, we can also look forward to Thanksgiving, which comes late this year on Thursday, Nov. 28, and also the Feast of St. Andrew, our parish patronal feast day, on Saturday, Nov. 30. I am planning to go to my home in Ada, Ohio, for Thanksgiving and I will celebrate the Thanksgiving Day Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Ada.

I have good news and bad news regarding our much-delayed church lighting project. The good news is that all of the new lighting fixtures and parts needed for the project are now available. The bad news is that the work to install the lighting will not take place until January. The reason for this is that the month of December is so busy with Advent and Christmas that it would cause too much disruption to close the sanctuary to erect scaffolding and other equipment needed to install the new lighting. So we decided to do the work in January when the disruption will be less of a problem. Just pray that the lights don't burn out before they can be replaced. Thank you for your patience!

I know that many people consider November to be a gloomy and melancholy time, but I have always liked this month. There is a peaceful austerity about it, very conducive to thoughtful introspection. May you enjoy these quiet days before hectic December comes.

EUCHARISTIC MIRACLES EXHIBIT: The Vatican-approved Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit will be held at St. John Neumann (Sunbury) on **Saturday, Nov. 30, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.** and **Sunday, Dec. 1, from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.** This Exhibit documents 152 miracles of the Eucharist that have been confirmed by the Vatican with panels cataloged by Blessed Carlo Acutis. Through the exhibit, one can "virtually visit" the places where the miracles took place. MAJOR RELICS OF ST. THOMAS AQUINAS: The major first-class relics of St. Thomas Aquinas (which includes the relic of his skull) will be available for public veneration at **St. Patrick Church** (280 N. Grant Ave.) on **December 7-8**. This is the first time that St. Thomas' major relics will tour the United States, through an arrangement between the Dominican Province of Toulouse, France, and the Dominican Province of St. Joseph (Eastern USA). The relic tour is in commemoration of the Triple Jubilee of St. Thomas Aquinas, the 700th anniversary of his canonization in 2023, the 750th anniversary of his death in 2024, and the 800th anniversary of his birth in 2025.

NOTES:

- For fiscal year 2023-24, total parish operating revenue increased over prior year driven by school tuition Ed Choice expansion program.
- Offertory decreased slightly from prior year, though flat to budget.
- Utility usage was down compared to prior year, in part from improved efficiency with new HVAC equipment.
- Salary and benefits came in higher than prior year driven by staff mix, salary increases, and higher group health costs, though lower than budget.
- Other revenue and expenditures were consistent with the prior year.
- School enrollment (440 students) increased from prior year.
- Religious Education staff reduction in July 2024 will impact expenses in 2024-25.
- The school incurred capital expenditures for HVAC rooftop units (initial \$218k) and new security cameras (\$45k) in 2023-24.

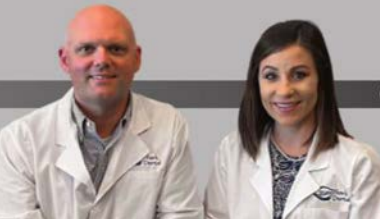
