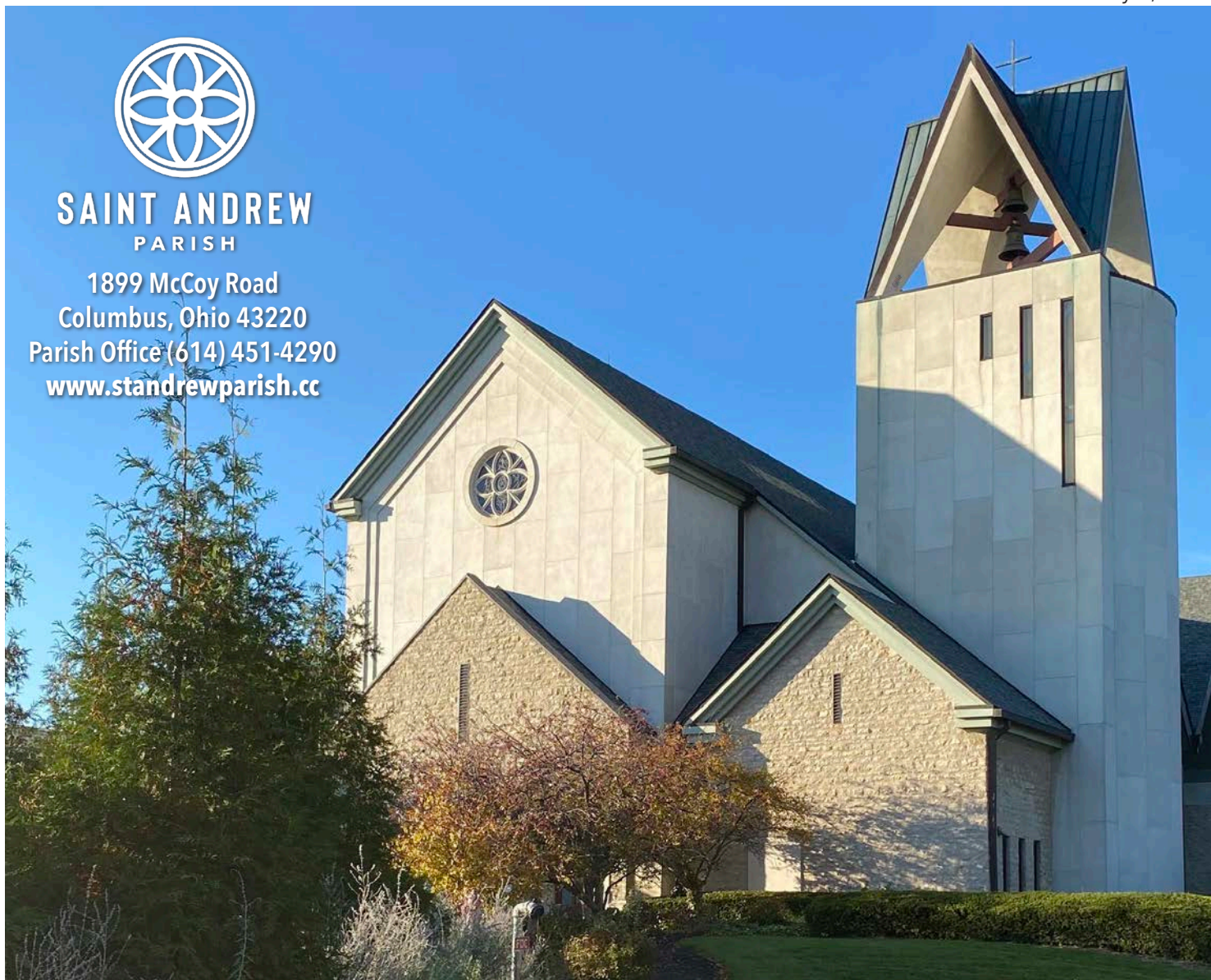

## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday (February 2), we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This feast commemorates the occasion when Mary and Joseph presented the child Jesus in the temple in Jerusalem 40 days after His birth. When Simeon saw the child Jesus, he declared "My eyes have seen your salvation...a light for revelation to the Gentiles."

Speaking of light, have you noticed that our church is now filled with beautiful light? Although the lighting project is not yet complete, our church is now awash with bright beautiful light. The remaining work that involves connecting the controls to the lighting will be completed this coming week. Then we will be able to have different settings and levels of lighting for different needs. I am extremely pleased with our bright new lighting.

On Saturday, February 22, the Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated here at St. Andrew Church. This will take place at the Saturday 4:30 p.m. Vigil Mass. We have 77 confirmands, which means "those to be confirmed." Because the church will be very full for this Confirmation Mass, and also because this Mass will probably last about 90 minutes or more, I would suggest that the regular attendees of the Saturday 4:30 p.m. Vigil Mass may want to plan on attending a different Mass on the weekend of February 22-23. Our church has 102 pews, and more than 70 of them will be filled with confirmands and their families, leaving only 28 pews for everyone else, including friends and relatives of the confirmands. So if you don't want to stand through a long Mass on the weekend of February 22-23, you are advised to avoid the 4:30 p.m. Vigil Mass on Saturday, February 22.

This is the month of February, the shortest month of the year that somehow always seems to drag on forever! May you remain safe and warm in these cold and dreary days.

student who is attending a Catholic high school in the 2025-2026 school year. Awards from the Nativity of Mary Scholarship are \$2,000 per year. Provided that the student remains in good standing and continues to attend a Catholic high school in the Diocese of Columbus, the scholarship will be renewed each year until that student graduates. **RONALD C. SULLIVAN SCHOLARSHIP** awards \$100,000 (\$25,000 per year) to graduating high school seniors who will be incoming freshman at Ohio State University. Ronald C. Sullivan was a man of faith, education, business, and duty. He considered his Catholicism the foundation of his identity and as a lifelong Buckeye of The Ohio State University, Sullivan saw a college education as a key to success.

**Scholarship requirements:** A current high school senior enrolled or about to enroll at The Ohio State University, a practicing Catholic (as verified by a letter from a parish leader such as a priest, deacon, or youth minister), active member of St. Andrew, St. Agatha, Our Lady of Victory, St. Christopher, and solid academic performance.

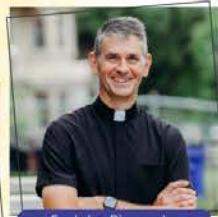

# The Mass

## ***“Do This in Remembrance of Me”*** **A Step-By-Step Walk Through the Mass**

Fr. Luke Spannagel

### ✦ Part 55: Saint Names in Eucharistic Prayer I ✦

As we have been reflecting on the Intercessions of the Eucharistic Prayers, perhaps it is a good time to address all those saint names in Eucharistic Prayer I. Who are all those people? Of course, the first list begins with Mary and Joseph and then the “blessed Apostles and Martyrs,” including Peter, Paul, Andrew (Peter’s brother), James (“the Greater”: the brother of John), John, Thomas, James (“the Lesser”: the son of Alphaeus), Matthew, Bartholomew, Simon (“the Zealot”), and Jude (also called Thaddeus).

#### **The First List of Saint Names**

Continuing this first list of saints in Eucharistic Prayer I, as Charles Belmonte notes, “Five popes head the list: St. Peter’s first three successors, Linus, Cletus, Clement; then two popes of the third century, Sixtus II and Cornelius; Cyprian, Bishop of Carthage, the intrepid defender of Catholic unity; the deacon Lawrence, who when his persecutor demanded from him the ‘treasures’ of the Church, showed him hundreds of poor people; Chrysogonus, a Roman priest who carried out the holy work of comforting the Christians who were in prison; two brothers, John and Paul, both officers of the [Roman] imperial palace, who were put to death under [the emperor] Julian the Apostate; and lastly, Cosmas and Damian, two Oriental physicians who gave their aid freely, and at whose graves there occurred ‘yet more cures than they had effected in their lives’” (Understanding the Mass, p. 158).

#### **The Second List of Saint Names**

As for the second list of saints in Eucharistic Prayer I, we ask for “some share in the fellowship” of several saints who were martyrs. Belmonte continues, “It mentions, in the first place, John (here obviously St. John the Baptist), and then seven men, followed by seven women, all martyrs. Stephen is the first deacon, whose glorious martyrdom is recounted in the Acts of the Apostles (6:8-7:60). Two apostles come next: Matthias, elected to take the place of Judas (Acts 1:15-16) and probably left out of the first list so as not to exceed the number of twelve, and Barnabas, St. Paul’s companion in his first missionary journey. Ignatius is the famous bishop of Antioch, sentenced to be fed to the wild beasts in Rome under [emperor] Trajano. Besides their names and the place of their martyrdom, little else is known of Alexander, the priest Marcellinus, and the exorcist Peter, who were all put to death in the great persecution of [emperor] Diocletian. The list continues with the names of the two young girls, Felicity and Perpetua (their names form the expression ‘everlasting happiness’), who confessed their faith at Carthage [in North Africa]; and of Agatha and Lucy in Sicily. It concludes with the names of two young martyrs beloved by the Romans, Agnes and Cecelia; and of Anastasia, martyred at Sirmium and later honored in Rome” (Understanding the Mass, pp. 159-160).

All these saints are important because they were among the many early witnesses to Jesus Christ and the Christian faith. These are our spiritual fathers, our older brothers and sisters in Christ, who showed us that our faith was worth living and dying for. They showed us that, strengthened by the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist and the presence of the Holy Spirit in their hearts, they could overcome any persecutions and sufferings, even to the point of being killed. These saints give us great hope, and their prayers for us give us confidence that we, too, can live out the faith as they did, that we can live our life in Christ every day and look forward to the glory of heaven!

#### **For Reflection:**

1. Fr. Luke explains the role of the saints featured in Eucharistic Prayer I in witnessing to the faith. Take time to pray by name for the people in your life who have witnessed the faith to you.
2. Next time you hear a celebrant use Eucharistic Prayer I, pay attention to the names in the list of saints and give thanks for their presence with us—as members of the Communion of Saints—at Mass.
