Dear Parishioners,

Today, Sunday March 3, we welcome Bishop Earl Fernandes to St. Andrew Parish at 3:00 p.m. for the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation. 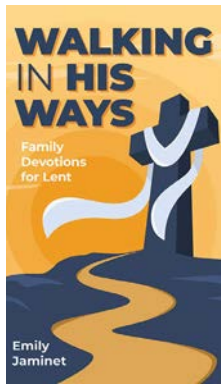
FORMED Available free of charge to St. Andrew parishioners, FORMED is a digital streaming service that provides amazing content 24/7 for you to grow in your faith.

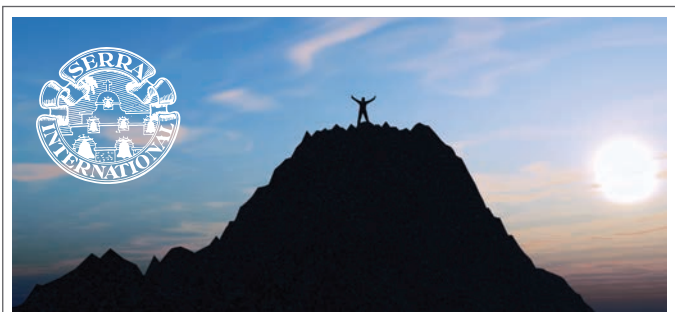
